Family-owned quality champagne house - fresh, creamy, fruity & structured

Special rosé for a special occasion

White

- Chenin Blanc**, Freedom Cross, Western Cape
Dry & zesty New World chenin blanc
- Semillon Sauvignon**, Vicuña, Central Valley
Deliciously crisp & refreshing blend of grapes traditionally used in white Bordeaux
- Vermentino**, Vignes de l'Eglise
Increasingly fashionable variety from Northern Italy & Southern France – aromatic, fresh & racy
- Garganega**, Torre del Falasco
Easier to drink than to say – the grape variety used for Soave. Soft, rounded, a lovely glass
- Chardonnay**, Comtesse de Marion
Well-made unoaked chardonnay from a family estate using all its own fruit, grown without pesticides or chemical fertilizers
- Sauvignon Blanc**, Tanner's, VdPd'Oc
Fresh grassy Sauvignon made for Tanners by well-known wine-makers, Lurton Frères
- Pinot Grigio delle Venezie**, Cortegiara
From the famous Italian winery, Allegrini. Light, refreshing & citrusy
- Sauvignon Blanc 2010**, Tummil Flat, Marlborough
Classic Marlborough Sauvignon – fresh, crisp, nettles & gooseberries
- Costières de Nîmes 2010**, La Tour de Beraud
Southern Rhône blend of Grenache Blanc, Roussanne & Marsanne, made with a lot of heart by Francois Collard on a small family property near Nimes – refreshing, elegant & mineral
- Albariño 2009**, Pazo San Mauro, Rias Baixas
Distinctive wine from Spain's Atlantic Coast – dry, with a tang of the sea. Great with fish
- Saint-Véran 2009**, Collovray & Terrier
Quality white burgundy from close to Pouilly-Fuissé – rich & delicious
- Douro White 2009**, Quinta da Romaneira
Double Silver medallist at IWC & Sommelier Wine Awards 2011, from an old estate in the unique Douro Valley - powerful, herb-scented, complex, delicious ♥
- Gavi di Gavi 2010**, Lugarara, La Giustiniana
Gavi di Gavi – so good they named it twice! Concentration & richness make it super food wine
- Chablis 2010**, St Martin, Domaine Laroche
Another silver medal winner – extremely drinkable Chablis, less austere than some
- Pouilly-Fumé 2009**, Domaine des Fines Caillottes, Jean Pabiot
Excellent fruit, classic flinty sauvignon from a Loire estate with 5 generations' experience

- Tempranillo**, Castiluzar, Navarra
Strawberry nose, good weight for drinking on its own or with food
- Merlot**, Ladera Verde, Central Valley
Very quaffable everyday Merlot – typically smooth & gentle
- Shiraz di Sicilia**, Villa Francesca
Good full-bodied full-flavoured Shiraz from Sicily
- Corvina**, Torre del Falasco
Easy-drinking light, red-fruited wine from a good co-operative – think Valpolicella
- Malbec**, Finca los Primos, San Rafael
Top choice to partner a great steak or something from the barbecue – rich, weighty feel with a soft silkiness
- Primitivo 2008**, A Mano, Puglia
All Mark Shannon's wines are loaded with pure flavour – deeply fruity without being a kick in the head. Great with hearty dishes.
- Rioja Crianza 2008**, Vega
Can a wine have good posture? This one has. Straight spine, well-muscled & a balanced temperament. Loves red meat.
- Cabernet Sauvignon 2008**, Cousiño-Macul Antiguas Reservas
Old-established family estate making classic Cabernet - good blackcurrant flavours & length
- Shiraz 2009**, House of Certain Views, Orange
Shiraz co-fermented with a little Viognier for rich, blackberry-fruit flavours with a gentle lift
- Pinot Noir 2009**, Maiden Flight Reserva, Bio Bio Valley
Made in a purpose-built winery solely for Pinot Noir, this is incredibly good for the price
- Côte de Brouilly 2009**, Les Volcaniques, J Charlet
Superb Beaujolais, light, juicy & delicious
- Chianti Classico 2008**, Isole e Olena
Mention Isole e Olena & Italian wine-lovers sigh with happiness. Paolo de Marchi, wine-maker there for over 30 years, takes Chianti to a different level. Amazing. Just try it ♥
- Chateauneuf-du-Pape 2009**, Closerie de Vaudieu
Wine guru Jancis Robinson describes this wine as “all pleasure”. Couldn't agree more.
- Nebbiolo 2008**, Massolino, Langhe
The Massolino family makes gold medal-winning Barolo, the king of Italian wines. This raspberry & rose scented Nebbiolo is a tempting introduction to their excellent range
- Givry 1er Cru 2008**, Clos Jus, Mouton
Refined & delicious Pinot Noir. Good value Burgundy need not be an oxymoron.
